7. What appeal did Paul make concerning a woman praying to God unveiled (11:13)?
8. What is a dishonor to a man and what is a glory to a woman (11:14-15)?
9. What was not found in the churches of God (11:16)?
10. What problem existed in the local church assembly at Corinth (11:17-19)?

11. What shameful and un-praiseworthy act was taking place in the assembly regarding the partaking of the Lord's supper (11:20-22)?
12. What was the purpose of the supper instituted by the Lord Jesus (11:23-26)?
13. What happens when a person eats and drinks of the Lord's supper in an unworthy manner (11:27-29)?
14. How did Paul describe the Corinthians who were misusing the Lord's supper (11:30)?
15. What solution did Paul give to the problem so the Corinthians would not be judged (11:31-34)?

1. What does "head" have reference to in 1 Corinthians 11:3?
2. What is known about the custom of women wearing a veil in Paul's day (11:6)?
3. Where in the gospels do we read about Jesus instituting the Lord's supper (11:23-26)?
• Applications for Today
1. It is important to imitate men like Paul rather than imitating worldly people today (11:1). Who else are Christians to imitate (Eph. 5:1; 1 Thess. 2:14; Heb. 6:12)?

2. It is important to hold fast the apostolic traditions and not change them or ignore them (11:2)? What did Paul write about traditions in 2 Thessalonians 2:15? What traditions are we to reject (Mk. 7:8, 9, 13; Col. 2:8)?
3. Headship (one's authority over another) must be honored at all times (11:3). What position does Jesus have over all mankind (Eph. 1:22-23)? What position does the husband have over the wife (Eph. 5:22-24)? What position does God have over Jesus (Jn. 17:1-4)?
4. Divisions and factions in a local church make manifest who is approved of God and who is not (11:17-19). What are division and faction a sign of (Gal. 5:20)? What does division make manifest according to John (1 Jn. 2:19)?
5. The Lord's supper is to remember the Lord's death (11:23-26). What is the purpose of a memorial (Josh. 4:4-7)?
6. Common meals are not to be partaken in the assembly, but at home (11:22, 33). Where did the early Christians eat common meals (Acts 2:46)?
