
## Lesson 6 1 Corinthians 6:1-20

1. Sometimes it is better for Christians to be wronged or defrauded in small matters rather than expose their problems before unbelievers (6:1-8). What did Jesus say to do when you are mistreated (Mt. 5:38-42)?
2. Unrighteous living will keep a person out of the church and out of heaven (6:9-10). What other kinds of practices will keep a person out of the kingdom (Gal. 5:19-21; Eph. 5:3-5)?
3. Unrighteous persons can repent and be forgiven (6:11). What does baptism do for the unrighteous person (Acts 22:16; Eph. 5:26; Tit. 3:5; Heb. 10:22)?
4. Some things that are "lawful" may not be "expedient" under certain circumstances (6:12; see also 1 Cor. 10:23). What is one thing that a Christian should abstain from if it would not be profitable to others (1 Cor. 6:13; 10:24-33)?
5. Fornication is sinful and not a proper use of the body (6:13-18). What will God do to fornicators who do not repent (Heb. 13:4; Rev. 21:8; 22:15)?
6. Our body is for the Lord (6:13) and a member of Christ (6:15). We are to keep our body pure and use it to glorify the God (6:19-20). How are we to present our body to God each day (Rom. 12:1)? What did Paul do with his body (Phil. 1:20)?
