### Raised With Him - cont.

Christians are raised with him to sit in heavenly places: "and raised us up with him, and made us to sit with him in the heavenly places, in Christ Jesus" (Ephesians 2:6).

Just as Jesus was raised to walk in a new life (Acts 1:3), Christians are raised with him to walk in newness of life: "We were buried therefore with him through baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we also might walk in newness of life. For if we have become united with him in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection" (Romans 6:4-5).

Just as Jesus was raised to go back to heaven (Acts 1:9-11), Christians are raised to focus on things that are above: "If then ye were raised together with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated on the right hand of God" (Colossians 3:1).

Just as Jesus was raised to life after death (I Corinthians 15:1-8), Christians will be resurrected after they die: "knowing that he that raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise up us also with Jesus, and shall present us with you" (2 Corinthians 4:14).

### **Christians With Christ**

Christians have been <u>crucified with</u> <u>Christ</u> when they put off the old man of sin: "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I that live, but Christ liveth in me: and that life which I now live in the flesh I live in faith, the faith which is in the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself up for me" (Galatians 2:20).


Christians have been <u>buried with</u>
<u>Christ</u> when they are baptized into
Christ: "having been buried with him in
baptism, wherein ye were also raised with
him through faith in the working of God,
who raised him from the
dead" (Colossians 2:12.

Christians <u>live with Christ</u> when they faithfully live for the Lord: "But if

we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him" (Romans 6:8).

Christians are <u>hid with Christ</u> when they are completely surrounded by Christ: "For ye died, and your life is hid with Christ in God" (Colossians 3:3).

Christians are joint-heirs with Christ when they share the same family blessings: "and if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ" (Romans 8:17).



Christians <u>suffer with Christ</u> when they are persecuted for the cause of Christ: "if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified with him" (Romans 8:17).

Christians <u>reign with Christ</u> when they rule over all their spiritual enemies: "if we endure, we shall also reign with him: if we shall deny him, he also will deny us" (2 Timothy

2:12).

Christians <u>sup with Christ</u> in close, personal fellowship when they hear his voice and obey it: "Behold, I stand at the door and knock: if any man hear my voice and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me" (Revelation 3:20).

Christians will be glorified with Christ when they enter heaven: "When Christ, who is our life, shall be manifested, then shall ye also with him be manifested in glory" (Colossians 3:4).

Christians will <u>be with Christ</u> when they enter heaven: "But I am in a strait betwixt the two, having the desire to depart and be with Christ; for it is very far better" (Phil. 1:23).

#### **Raised With Him**

Just as Jesus was made alive again (Luke 24:5), Christians are raised with him in baptism to be made alive again: "having been buried with him in baptism, wherein ye were also raised with him through faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead" (Colossians 2:12).

Just as Jesus was raised to sit at the right hand of God (Acts 2:30-33),
