

"Give your servant therefore an understanding heart"

- 1 Kings 3:9 -

King Solomon

• King Solomon – "the wisest man" (1 K. 1-11; 2 Chron. 1-9)

 Prayer is a broad topic; we will focus on what to ask for in this lesson

• What did Solomon ask for (1 Kings)?

He asked for something <u>spiritual</u>
(3:4-9)

He asked for something <u>influencial</u>
(3:10-15; 4:29-34; 10:23)

 He asked for something judicial (3:16-28)

He asked for something <u>practical</u>
(3:29-34; see Proverbs, Eccl., S. of S.)

He asked for something <u>religious</u>
(5:1 – 9:28; see 5:7, 12)

He asked for something <u>educational</u>
(10:1-13)

He asked for something <u>personal</u> (11:1-13)

 He was supposed to walk in God's ways, but chose not to later in life (2:1-9; 3:14; 6:11-13; 9:1-9)

We need to know what to ask for (Jas. 4:1-3)

 Look at the prayers of godly men and women in the Bible (see H. Lockyer's "All the Prayers of the Bible")

What did Moses, the Psalmist, or the prophets pray for in the OT?

What did Jesus, NT Christians, or Paul pray for in the NT?
