

bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ 2 Corinthians 10:5

The Christian's Mind

Christians often think about their body [body building], but not their mind [mind building] (2 Cor. 10:5; 11:3)

The world has a mind different from the Christian

Why Develop the Mind? 1. God has commanded it (Mk. 12:30) 2. Unbelief is militant today (2 Tim. 3:8) 3. The renewing of the mind is a continual process (Rom. 12:2; Eph. 4:23)

Why Develop the Mind?

4. The new covenant laws are to be written on the heart <u>and</u> mind (Heb. 8:10; 10:16)

5. Christians are to be disciplined: to have the mind of Christ (Phil. 2:5; 1 Pet. 4:1) and to think a certain way (Phil. 4:7-8)

How To Develop the Mind Know the scriptures (Acts 17:11) Study culture (Rom. 1:28; 2 Cor. 3:14; 4:4; Eph. 4:17; Col. 1:21; 1 Tim. 6:5; Tit. 1:15)

Analyze events theologically

How To Develop the Mind Does the Bible speak (generically or specifically) to this issue? Does this issue violate absolute standards of morality or value?

- Study culture

How To Develop the Mind

God is

Jesus Christ died for the sins of mankind

The Bible contains the revealed word of God and absolute truth

How To Develop the Mind We are made in the image of God Sin is a violation of God's law History is linear moving to a judgment There are two eternal destinies after death

What is Christian Thinking? Spiritually, not fleshly (Rom. 8:5-7; see) Mt. 16:23; 1 Cor. 2:16; Eph. 2:3; Col. 2:18) Humbly, not proudly (Acts 20:19) Maturally, not immaturally (1 Cor. 14:20)

What is Christian Thinking? Heavenly, not earthly (Col. 3:2; Phil. 3:15, 19)Soberly, not recklessly (Tit. 2:2, 5, 6) Sincerely, not hypocritically (2 Pet. 3:1)

What is Christian Thinking?

Wisely, not foolishly (Rev. 17:9)
