2. How long did Shallum reign over Israel and how did he die (2 K. 15:13-15)?
3. How long did Menahem reign over Israel and what kind of king was he (2 K. 15:16-22)?
4. How long did Pekahiah reign over Israel, what kind of king was he, and how did he die (2 K. 15:23-26)?
5. How long did Pekah reign over Israel, what kind of king was he, and how did he did (2 K. 15:27-31)?
6. How long did Jotham reign over Judah and what kind of king was he (2 K. 15:32-38 2 Chron. 27:1-2)?
7. What did Jotham do to show his might and why was he mighty (2 Chron. 27:3-9)?

## **Digging Deeper**

1. What are the approximate dates for the reigns of Zechariah, Shallum, Menahem, Pekahiah, and Pekah over Israel (2 K. 15:8-31)? What are the approximate dates for Jotham's reign over Judah (2 K. 15:32-38)?

- 2. Where earlier in 2 Kings do we read about the Lord speaking to Jehu concerning his sons who would sit on the throne (2 K. 15:12)?
- 3. Who was Pul king of Assyria (2 K. 15:19-20; see also 1 Chron. 5:26) and who was Tiglath-pileser king of Assyria (2 K. 15:29; see also 16:7, 10)?
- 4. Which "major" prophet and which two "minor" prophets ministered during reign of Jotham king of Judah?
- 5. What genealogy was reckoned in the days of Jotham king of Judah?
- 6. What did Jotham refuse to do that his father Uzziah had done (2 Chron. 27:2)?
