






Map of Carmel and the Wilderness of Paran

- 1. Outward beauty is not as important as inward character (25:3, 33; 1 Tim. 2:9-10; 1 Pet. 3:1-6).
- 2. Do not return evil for good (25:21; Psa. 35:12; 38:20; 109:5; Prov. 17:13; Jer. 18:20).
- 3. A soft answer turns away wrath (25:23-31; Prov. 15:1).


4. God's people are blessed and protected by him as they are "bound in the bundle of life" (25:29; Prov. 3:33). God helps his people (1 Chron. 12:18; Acts 26:22).

- 5. Be willing to reject a bad idea even if it comes from someone close to you (26:8-11; 2 Tim. 2:23).
- 6. Do not engage in revenge. Let God take care of the evil-doer (26:9-11; Rom. 12:17-21).
- 7. Be careful from whom you get your advice and counsel (26:19; Psa. 1:1).

- 8. Admit your sin when you commit it; don't try to hide it or excuse it (26:21; Jas. 5:16; 1 Jn. 1:9).
- 9. The Lord rewards everyone for their righteousness and faithfulness (26:23; Prov. 15:9; 21:21).
