- 6. When was the first time that Solomon was anointed king (29:22)?

Applications for Today

- 1. Even tasks that appear to be trivial and mundane (like the doorkeepers) are important to the Lord and to his work (26:1-19; Psa. 84:10).
- 2. Able and strong individuals are needed to serve in the Lord's house (26:8-9; 1 Cor. 16:13).
- 3. Counselors who use discretion, wisdom, and understanding are needed to serve in the Lord's house (26:14; Prov. 1:4; 2:11; 3:21).
- 4. Mighty men of valor are needed to serve in the Lord's house (26:30-31; Eph. 6:10).
- 5. Good leaders will obey the Lord. Constant and consistent obedience to the Lord's commands brings success (28:7-8; Phil. 2:12).
- 6. Serving the Lord with a perfect heart and a willing mind brings success and joy (28:9; 29:9, 14, 17, 19; 1 Tim. 6:18).
- 7. Strength, courage, and action (do it) are needed to complete the Lord's work (28:10, 20-21; see also 22:13; 1 Cor. 15:58).
- 8. We can be successful with the Lord's help and with the help of willing brethren (28:20-21; 1 Tim. 5:16; Heb. 13:5).
- 9. Both willingness and skill are needed to do the Lord's work (28:21; Phil. 2:13).
- 10. The Lord is great and powerful and worthy to be praised (29:10-13; Rev. 11:17).
- 11. When we give to the Lord we are simply giving back to him what he has given to us (29:14-17; 2 Cor. 9:6-11).
- 12. It is good to bless the Lord (29:20; 2 Cor. 1:3; 11:31; Eph. 1:3; 1 Tim. 6:15; 1 Pet. 1:3).
