


But the word of God grew and multiplied – Acts 12:24


So the churches were strengthened in the faith, and increased in number daily – Acts 16:5

Acts 19 Lessons for Today

- 1. A good way to do personal evangelism is start with a question about one's religion (19:2; Acts 8:30).
- 2. Baptism places one "into the name of the Lord Jesus" (19:5; Acts 8:16; 1 Cor. 1:13).
- 3. Don't be hardened and disobedient to the truth (19:9; Rom. 10:21)?

Acts 19 Lessons for Today

4. Put away for good your old manner of life in this world and don't go back to it (19:19; Lk. 14:33).

5. For some people, the love of money and popularity keep them from accepting the truth of God's word and being saved (19:24-27; 1 Tim. 6:9-10).

Acts 19 Lessons for Today

6. Some people allow themselves to get stirred up into a frenzy and go along with a crowd, but they really don't know why they are there. They are ruled by emotion rather than by reason (19:32; Acts 21:34).
