

## **Applications for Today**

- 1. The Lord keeps his promises. His words will always come to pass (1:1; 1 Pet. 1:23-25).

- 3. There is still work to be done on the Lord's house today. His house (temple) continues to be built today as souls are added to his church (1:2-5; Eph. 2:20-21; 1 Tim. 3:15).

## **Applications for Today**

- 4. The Lord wants us to give free-will offerings to accomplish his work (1:4, 6; 2:68-69; 2 Cor. 9:6-7).
- 5. We strengthen our brethren when we support them in the work they are doing for the Lord (1:6; Acts 16:5).
- 6. All of God's law must be followed at all times and in all places (2:59-63; Phil. 2:12).

## **Applications for Today**

7. The Lord's priesthood is to be pure, not polluted (2:62; 1 Pet. 2:5, 9).

#### Ezra I-2: Return

- It took a special kind of Jew with a heart of sacrifice to return and build the temple (1:3,5-6; 2:68-69; see Psa. 137)
- Do we have the sacrifice to leave a life of comfort and return to living in God's kingdom (Lk. 9:23, 57-62; 13:23-24)?
