Stones (v. 3, 7)	Hearts / Spirit (v. 3, 8)
Condemnation (v. 9)	Righteousness (v. 9)
Glory (v. 7)	Exceeds in glory (v. 8-9)
Passing away (v. 7, 11)	Remains (v. 11)
Put a veil on (v. 13)	Unveiled face (v.18)
Veil remains (v. 14-15)	Veil taken away (v. 16)

8 Characteristics of Letters

1. Written on and with materials
2. Read by one or more persons
3. Written for the benefit of others
4. Convey a message from an author

8 Characteristics of Letters

5. Bear the name of their author
6. Should be written to be easily read
7. Can be blotted or blemished
8. Can be destroyed, but remembered

7. Not commit adultery	1 Cor. 6:9-10; Heb. 13:4
8. Not steal	Eph. 4:28
9. Not bear false witness	Eph. 4:25; Rev. 21:8
10. Not covet	Col. 3:5
