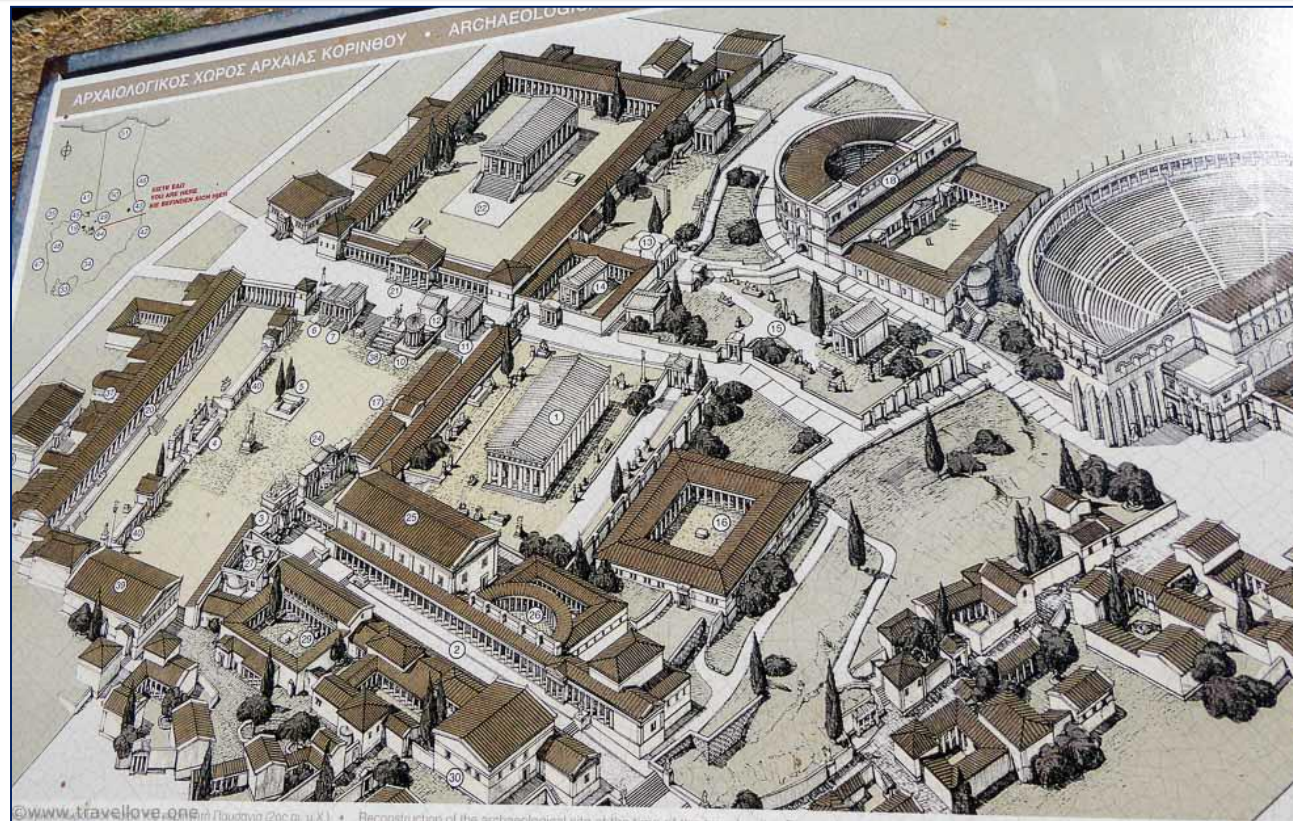

# Background

- Authorship: Paul (1:1; 10:1)
- Place: Macedonia (Acts 20:1-2; 2 Cor. 2:12-13; 7:5)
- Time: c. A.D. 56

# Background

- Occasion: False teachers came to Corinth and tried to stir up the Christians there against Paul (11:13-15, 22)
- Paul was falsely accused

# Background

- Paul sent Titus to Corinth with “Second Corinthians” to deal with these problems (7:7:6-7, 14-15), before Paul himself came there for the “third time” (12:14, 21; 13:1; Acts 20:2-3)

# Background

- Second Corinthians is Paul's defense of his conduct, character, calling, and credentials as an apostle of Jesus Christ
- Sometimes Christians have to defend their actions when falsely accused

# The Tone of 2 Corinthians

- A tone of **confident joy** (1-7; see 7:16)
- The collection (8-9)
- A tone of **confident rebuke** (10-13; see 13:2)
