Does Jesus Care?

*Casting all your care upon him; for he cares for you.
- 1 Peter 5:7 -*

People generally want to know if others care for them. Children want to know if their parents care for them. The elderly want to know if their family cares for them. Citizens want to know if their government cares for them. Employees want to know if their boss cares for them. Students want to know if the teacher cares for them.

As Christians go through life, they also want to know if God and Jesus care for them. They often experience troubles and trials and they want to know if someone is caring for them and will help them. Yes, both God and Jesus care. Read the above scripture again. He cares for YOU!

One reason Jesus is able to care for us so greatly is because he himself had to experience what we go through in life. He cares because he knows first-hand what we are going through. Consider what the author of Hebrews wrote:

For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succor them that are tempted. - Hebrews 2:18

Let's take a look at when Jesus cares for you and how Jesus cares for you.

When Jesus Cares

- Jesus cares when you have personal property loss because he had to give up things (Matthew 8:19-20; Luke 8:1-3; 2 Corinthians 8:9).
- Jesus cares when you are falsely accused and persecuted because he experienced the same thing (John 15:20).
- Jesus cares when you have a close friend betray you or leave you, because those close to him abandoned him (John 13:18,36-38; Psalm 41:9).
- Jesus cares when you are rejected because of your beliefs because he was rejected by his own (John 1:11).
- Jesus cares when you are rejected by your own family members because there was a time when his own brothers did not believe in him (John 7:5).
- Jesus cares when you are criticized for your godly actions because he was criticized and called names (Matthew 9:10-12; 11:18-19; John 5:15-16).
- Jesus cares when you are misunder-

stood by those around you because his life mission was misunderstood (Luke 4:23-30).

- Jesus cares when you lose a loved one to death because he lost his friend Lazarus (John 11:32-36).
- Jesus cares when you are grieved over those lost in sin because he was grieved (Matthew 9:36-38; 23:37; Luke 19:41-44).
- Jesus cares when you are tempted of the Devil because he was tempted (Matthews 4:1-11; Luke 22:28).
- Jesus cares when you bare the burden of sin because he was made a sin sacrifice (2 Corinthians 5:21; Hebrews 1:3; 1 Peter 2:24).
- Jesus cares when you experience pain because he experienced the severe pain of the cross (Matthew 27:30).
- Jesus cares when you face death because he faced death too (Mark 10:33-34).
