many in charge are wanting to "go soft on crime" and abolish the death penalty. Many citizens engage in violence without being punished and murder increases. Abortion continues.

Unauthorized religion is on the increase as well as sexual immorality because we are "tolerant" of everyone's beliefs and lifestyles. Materialism continues to increase. Divorce is higher today than years ago. Like ancient Israel, many citizens in America don't "blush" any more when they engage in sin (Jeremiah 3:3; 6:15; 8:12).

Is There Hope for America?

Yes, I believe God will continue to bless America. But, "In God We Trust" must be our motto, not "In the US we trust" (Psalm 147:10-11; Jeremiah 9:23). We must give up our sin and pride (Proverbs 16:18). We must learn the lessons of ancient nations like Assyria (Isaiah 10:12-13), Babylon (Daniel 5:20-31), Tyre (Ezekiel 28:2), and Philistia (Zechariah 9:6) which all fell.

"God bless America." May these three words never become empty on the lips of United States politicians or citizens (Proverbs 14:34).

God Rules the Nations

The reason that God has and can continue to bless America is because God rules over all the nations of the world. And because he rules over all people, he can either curse them or bless them based upon their disobedience or obedience toward him (Psalm

9:19-20; 99:1-2).

God, through is providential working, can control the hearts of world leaders. He can put them in power and remove them from power when they become proud (Proverbs 21:1; Daniel 4:25,32). This is why we constantly need to pray for our leaders (1 Timothy 2:1-2).

- A nation that has turned from God needs to turn back to God (Hosea 4:6; 7:10; 8:3,7; 10:13; 11:7; 13:9)
