### The local church and preacher training

- ▶ The biblical pattern (2 Tim. 2:2)
- The worldly pattern: churches build a school (institution) to do its work of teaching the Bible and training preachers

### Before you start a training program

- Does the local church really want this?
  - Will they encourage the trainee in what he is doing each week? Will they make the sacrifice?
  - Will they be willing to give him financial support?

#### Before you start a training program

- Are you going to commit to this and see it through to the end?
  - Do you really have the time? He is watching you, not just learning from you
  - Your wife and family will also be affected

#### Select a man, or men to train

- A man from the local church, or from another place
- Choose a conscientious, hard worker
- Talk to him in advance about what is planned and what will be expected of him

#### Select the amount of time for training

- A minimum of 3 to 6 months, or possibly 1 year
- As along as he can to stay

#### Select the place for study

- A quiet place for uninterrupted study
- You have to have quiet time away from family, church members, and your cell phone

#### Select the weekly schedule

- Make a general schedule: what is done on each day
- Make a specific list of weekly duties: what you will do and what he will do
- Print a copy of the schedule

### Select the specific duties and responsibilities

- Preaching sermons
- Teaching Bible class
- Writing a bulletin article
- Speaking on a radio program

### Select the specific duties and responsibilities

- Visiting church members during the week
- Personal evangelism
- Personal Bible reading and study

### Select the specific duties and responsibilites

- Etc. (the duties will change depending upon what the local preacher and church are currently doing)
- Print a copy of the duties

## Select the biblical material to study

- What specific books of the Bible will be read and studied? (1-2 Timothy and Titus should be included)
- What topics, in or out of the Bible, will be studied?

### Follow-up after the training program ends

- Assess the program: What did the trainee learn and what does he still need to learn? What did you learn and how can you improve the program for the future? What would you do differently?
- Continue to provide the newly trained preacher with advice

- Continue to provide him with sermons, study materials, books, etc.
- Continue to provide him with places to preach
- Continue to provide him with financial support, if possible
