

The "One Another" Passages in the New Testament
(American Standard Version)

Positives

1. Salt is good: but if the salt have lost its saltiness, wherewith will ye season it? Have salt in yourselves, and be at peace one with another (Mark 9:50)
2. If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, have washed your feet, ye also ought to wash one another's feet (John 13:14)
3. A new commandment I give unto you, that ye love one another; even as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another (John 13:34-35)
4. This is my commandment, that ye love one another, even as I have loved you (John 15:12)
5. These things I command you, that ye may love one another (John 15:17)
6. so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and severally members one of another (Romans 12:5)
7. In love of the brethren be tenderly affectionate one to another; in honor preferring one another (Romans 12:10)
8. Be of the same mind one toward another. Set not your mind on high things, but condescend to things that are lowly. Be not wise in your own conceits (Romans 12:16)
9. Owe no man anything, save to love one another: for he that loves his neighbor hath fulfilled the law (Romans 13:8)
10. So then let us follow after things which make for peace, and things whereby we may edify one another (Romans 14:19)
11. Now the God of patience and of comfort grant you to be of the same mind one with another according to Christ Jesus (Romans 15:5)
12. Wherefore receive ye one another, even as Christ also received you, to the glory of God (Romans 15:7)

13. And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another (Romans 15:14)
14. Salute one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ salute you (Romans 16:16)
15. Wherefore, my brethren, when ye come together to eat, wait one for another (1 Corinthians 11:33)
16. that there should be no schism in the body; but *that* the members should have the same care one for another (1 Corinthians 12:25)
17. All the brethren salute you. Salute one another with a holy kiss (1 Corinthians 16:20)
18. All the brethren salute you. Salute one another with a holy kiss (2 Corinthians 13:12)
19. For ye, brethren, were called for freedom; only *use* not your freedom for an occasion to the flesh, but through love be servants one to another (Galatians 5:13)
20. Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ (Galatians 6:2)
21. with all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love (Ephesians 4:2)
22. Wherefore, putting away falsehood, speak ye truth each one with his neighbor: for we are members one of another (Ephesians 4:25)
23. and be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving each other, even as God also in Christ forgave you (Ephesians 4:32)
24. speaking one to another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord (Ephesians 5:19)
25. subjecting yourselves one to another in the fear of Christ (Ephesians 5:21)
26. *doing* nothing through faction or through vainglory, but in lowliness of mind each counting other better than himself (Philippians 2:3)
27. forbearing one another, and forgiving each other, if any man have a complaint against any; even as the Lord forgave you, so also do ye (Colossians 3:13)
28. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly; in all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts unto God (Colossians 3:16)

29. and the Lord make you to increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all men, even as we also *do* toward you (1 Thessalonians 3:12)
30. But concerning love of the brethren ye have no need that one write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another (1 Thessalonians 4:9)
31. Wherefore comfort one another with these words (1 Thessalonians 4:18)
32. Wherefore exhort one another, and build each other up, even as also ye do (1 Thessalonians 5:11)
33. See that none render unto any one evil for evil; but always follow after that which is good, one toward another, and toward all (1 Thessalonians 5:15)
34. We are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren, even as it is meet, for that your faith grows exceedingly, and the love of each one of you all toward one another abounds (2 Thessalonians 1:3)
35. but exhort one another day by day, so long as it is called To-day; lest anyone of you be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin (Hebrews 3:13)
36. and let us consider one another to provoke unto love and good works; not forsaking our own assembling together, as the custom of some is, but exhorting one another; and so much the more, as ye see the day drawing nigh (Hebrews 10:24-25)
37. Confess therefore your sins one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The supplication of a righteous man avails much in its working (James 5:16)
38. Seeing ye have purified your souls in your obedience to the truth unto unfeigned love of the brethren, love one another from the heart fervently (1 Peter 1:22)
39. using hospitality one to another without murmuring (1 Peter 4:9)
40. Likewise, ye younger, be subject unto the elder. Yea, all of you gird yourselves with humility, to serve one another: for God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble (1 Peter 5:5)
41. Salute one another with a kiss of love. Peace be unto you all that are in Christ (1 Peter 5:14)
42. but if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin (1 John 1:7)
43. For this is the message which ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another (1 John 3:11)

44. And this is his commandment, that we should believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, even as he gave us commandment (1 John 3:23)
45. Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loves is begotten of God, and knows God (1 John 4:7)
46. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No man hath beheld God at any time: if we love one another, God abides in us, and his love is perfected in us (1 John 4:11-12)
47. And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote to thee a new commandment, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another (2 John 5)

Negatives

48. Let us not therefore judge one another anymore: but judge ye this rather, that no man put a stumbling block in his brother's way, or an occasion of falling (Romans 14:13)
49. But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another (Galatians 5:15)
50. Let us not become vainglorious, provoking one another, envying one another (Galatians 5:26)
51. lie not one to another; seeing that ye have put off the old man with his doings (Colossians 3:9)
52. For we also once were foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, hating one another (Titus 3:3)
53. Speak not one against another, brethren. He that speaks against a brother, or judges his brother, speaks against the law, and judges the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge (James 4:11)
54. Murmur not, brethren, one against another, that ye be not judged: behold, the judge stands before the doors (James 5:9)
